Dear Dr. Coleman,

On Tuesday night the Council awarded you a pension of £178:10:9 per year, dating from the 1st September, in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government and Other Officers Superannuation Act 1922.

I have pleasure therefore, in forwarding you a cheque for one month's pension to the 30th September £16:17:6, together with the amount standing to your credit in your personal account, namely, £30:2:10. This latter amount is made up by contributions amounting to £33:16:9 plus 4/10 accumulated interest, less £3:18:9 Income Tax, which is deducted in accordance with the provisions of the Finance Act 1922.
